Centaur (human top; horse bottom)

Symbol: arrow

Your inner beast is the mighty centaur. You live your life by integrity and logic. While others get tired, lazy, or bored, you have the ability to find your inner strength and get the job done. You don't mind hard work—if something is worth doing it's worth doing well. You have opinions, but you don't feel the need to push them on others. Your friendship is valuable and your friends know it—but they should be honest with you or else they might lose your respect. Out of all the beasts, centaurs are the ones to turn to in times of trouble, because no beast is more insightful, grounded, reliable, and reasonable.

Chimera (three heads- dragon, lion, and goat; lion body, bat wings, snake tail)

Chimeras are natural born leaders—full of compassion, charisma, and confidence. They approach the world with the right mix of authority, concern, and altruism. They're keen on encouraging others to do right in the world. They feel comfortable speaking their mind and are great at communication. They tend to rely on logic and facts, with a dash of emotion to make their point. Chimeras have high standards which can exhaust the other beasts who can't keep up. Although chimeras like to be busy, they enjoy quiet time to re-charge. Ultimately, chimeras are fantastic at leading the charge toward a better world.

Dragon

Symbol: silhouette of dragon circling a sun; sun color corresponds to dragon jewel type

Dragons are energized by doing. They take risks, live in the moment, and rules exist to be broken. Never confuse their lack of interest in philosophy with a lack of intelligence—dragons are brilliant but prefer to focus their talents on activities and getting stuff done. They love laughing and people, and are eager to help those in need, often with a big smile. Sometimes their passion and energy can interfere with getting through boring school work, but dragons thrive when they find creative ways to keep learning interesting. Dragons can get so caught up in their passions and special projects that they may need reminders to take care of themselves. But when dragons are well rested and well fed, they're ready to do big things in a big world.

Elf lord or Elf lady

Symbol: curlicue leaves

Out of all the beasts, elves hold to the highest standards of morality and ethics. Although they're soft spoken, they believe deeply in and strive to achieve the noble ideals of society. Elves utilize their amazing thinking skills to create unique ways to help the world reach a perfect and balanced harmony. They have a particular knack for tackling complex issues and diving into the heart of problems with an eye toward making big changes to help the less fortunate. Elves fight tyranny with love and believe in karma. They welcome others with warmth and empathy. Even though elves are quiet and thoughtful, they enjoy spending time with others. Out of all the beasts, elves are the ones ready to right the wrongs of the world.

Gorgon (human head and torso; snake tail and hair)

Symbol: snake-headed asterisk

The only thing gorgons have in common with their distant snake cousins is the ability to strike to the heart of any matter. Gorgons are incredibly insightful and have the amazing skill of grasping the facts of situations easily. They have the knack of making the most complicated things easy and pushing through toward success. They believe that hard work builds strong character. They despise laziness, cheating, and especially lying. Gorgons value family traditions. They thrive in an orderly world and they dedicate themselves to building harmonious communities. Gorgons will gravitate into the role of organizing others in meaningful ways. They respect authority, especially leaders that have earned their positions through hard work and diligence. When confronted, gorgons remain dignified and stick to their beliefs. Gorgons are the glue that hold the world together. If a gorgon makes you a promise, then lucky you! They'll always deliver.

Griffin (eagle head, talons, and wings; lion haunches and tail)

Symbol: eagle talon

Griffins are natural born leaders. Their charisma and confidence commands authority. Nothing gets a griffin's heart pumping like an impossible challenge which they will pursue until they conquer. Griffins see the big picture and negotiate with the strategic long game in mind. Griffins are quick to see the faults in others and despise incompetence, inefficiency, and laziness. Griffins should remember to soften their approach with some of the gentler quieter beasts, if they can do that, success will always be theirs.

Kitsune (fox with many tails)

Symbol: curling smoke, fox

Kitusne are a complex mix of endless creativity and logic. In fact, they are the most logical of all the beasts. They are mistakenly labeled as absent minded or daydreaming, but in truth their minds are buzzing with ideas. It's sometimes hard to keep up with their logic because they think as they go, using others to bounce ideas off. A kitsune is never far away from leaping to an unexpected, inventive, and brilliant connection. They're relaxed with friends, are eager to offer a solution for a beast with a problem, and have the confidence to stick up for their beliefs even when others disagree. The biggest obstacle for kitsune is being forced into the practical and boring grind of chores and homework. They shine in flexible environments that provide time to think about world ideas.

Ludian (green muscular deer, single horn on head, horse tail)

Symbol: tree

Luduans are effortlessly quick witted and love mental sparring. Their idea of fun is taking a position and encouraging people to see things their way. They have an unquenchable thirst for knowledge and are great at tackling old problem and applying new solutions. Luduans truly shine when faced with a challenge, but they're not so keen on the daily grind of chores and homework. They like to get to the heart of a situation and will never beat around the bush. Luduans should consider softening their uncanny honesty for the softer, gentler beasts. But one's thing for sure, when a luduan is around, they're always ready to score the win.

Manticore (human head/lion body/bat wings/scorpion tail)

Symbol: barbed stinger

Don't be fooled by the manticore's ferocious appearance, in truth, there's nothing more important to a manticore than family and friends. Just like their lion and bat cousins, manticores form deep, meaningful, warm connections to loved ones—and will protect their loved ones by tooth and claw...or stinger. Although manticores tend to leave things to the last minute, they still pull off sparkling results. They don't feel the need to step into the spot light, and are instead content with a job well done. Manticores are truly a mash-up of different beasts: one minute reserved and analytical, then next filled with biting wit, but underneath they are always truly caring. It's good to know a manticore—they give the best gifts!

Pterippus (winged horse)

Symbol: feather

Pterippi are always the life of the party. They are the beasts that spontaneously break into song and dance—and encourage others to join them. Their world is full of fun, friends, and life. Out of all the beasts, pterippi are the most gifted at reading the emotions in a room. They shine in

the spotlight—not only are they entertaining, but they’re well dressed and have a great eye for style. Pterippi know what they like and have the confidence to surround themselves with the things they love. Pterippi make great friends—always ready with a shoulder to cry on and offering a ton of support. Pterippi aren’t so keen on keeping up with daily responsibilities though, and are likely to spend their allowance just as fast as they get it. Even though pterippi like a lively world, they avoid melodrama. Pterippi like luck, and even better, luck likes them!

Sea Lady or Sea Lord (merpeople- human head and torso, fish tail)

Symbol: ocean wave

Out of all the beasts, merpeople are the most social. They have good friends and throw good parties. Merpeople genuinely care about others and like to keep up with the goings on in their loved ones lives. On the outside, merpeople are stylish and have a flair for fashion, underneath they’re practical, good natured, and can take care of business. They’re not so interested in vague ideas and prefer instead to focus on the here and now. Merpeople love to help others and are often selfless. Even though everybody values and appreciates the friendliness and practicality of the merpeople, they sometimes feel crushed by imagined criticism. But in truth, the merperson’s warmth, sensitivity, and rationality makes them natural leaders.

Sphinx (human head/lion body/feather wings)

Symbol: logarithmic spiral (the golden spiral)

Friends, friends, and more friends. Sphinxes know everybody. And everybody loves them for their compassionate charm. All that empathy has its downside, though, and sphinxes tend to worry that they’ve hurt other beast’s feelings. It’s not just friends that interest the sphinx though, they see the world as a great big puzzle of mystery and magic to explore and discover. These independent free thinkers are bored with day to day activities, and—if they resist their natural tendency to stay out of the spotlight—are primed to be great leaders and gurus.

Unicorn princess or unicorn prince (horned horse)

Symbol: star

No beast is more appreciative of creativity than unicorns. Unicorns love people and ideas and live in a colorful, exciting world. These free spirits live in the moment and bust out a happy dance when a new experience is on the horizon. Unicorns are never boring—they’re spontaneous, unpredictable, and like to push past the boundaries of the expected. Unicorns can have a dark side, though—watch out for their temper! As busy as a unicorn’s world is, they require time alone to re-charge, reflect, and re-feed their souls.

Valkyries (human with large feathered wings)

Symbol: feathered wing

The intellectual Valkyries see their world like a giant chess board. They're imaginative yet decisive, ambitious but private. Valkyries are proud to be bookworms and have an unquenchable thirst for knowledge. They believe that with effort and intelligence nothing is impossible. They also tend to believe that most beasts are simply too lazy and undisciplined to reach their goals. Valkyries are remarkably insightful, quick witted, and express themselves with a touch of sarcasm. Secretly, they view some social conventions as downright stupid. You can always count on a Valkyries' logic and they tackle problems with the perfect balance of intellect and morality. Valkyries are brilliant in their fields!

Vulcan (human appearance—ancient Greek creators—not Star Trek!)

Symbol: hammer

Vulcans are the builders and do-ers of the beast world. No other beast is more likely to roll up their sleeves and dig right in. They are intensely curious and tackle their interests with vigorous practicality and creativity. Vulcans don't want to learn by hearing or reading about stuff, they learn by hands-on doing. Like every inventor, they believe in trial and error. Vulcans are friendly and helpful, but need their quiet time to tackle their projects. They typically have a few things going on at the same time—and they don't mind jumping a new, fascinating, amazing project to the front of the line. Vulcans are fair but can sometimes step on other beasts' toes—especially if something has caught their eye. Give a Vulcan a challenge and they will build the solution.

Water horse/Hippocampus (horse head and front legs; fish tail)

Symbol: swirling water bubbles

Water horses are mistaken for being shy, but they're actually bursting with passion beneath their reserved exteriors. They're guided by the higher principles: morality, honor, and virtue. Water horses take pride in living their lives adhering to a code of thoughtful morals and ethics. They have the particular knack of discovering the good in beasts and urging them to better themselves. Not surprisingly, water horses connect deeply with others. Metaphors, reading, and poetry further deepen the water horse's already shrewd insight on the world and the people in it. Water horses prefer harmony and can become overwhelmed when the world is in political or environmental turmoil. They have a knack with language—either speaking multiple languages or just being able to explain their thoughts in compelling ways. Beneath the water horse's calm surface, swirls an ocean of passion, strength, and the vitality of a magnificent beast.
